Teaching Assistants are assigned to specific courses. Research Assistants are assigned to faculty and work with them on specific research projects.

For a student to be considered for appointment as a Teaching or Research Assistant, he/she must currently be a graduate student in good standing or must have submitted an application for admission to one of the School's graduate programs. All students must have a current minimum GPA of 3.0 and GRE scores on file. Teaching and Research Assistantships are assigned during the admissions process. You will be notified whether you have been awarded an assistantship at the time you are notified of your admission status. Unless otherwise indicated, assistantships are year-long positions. Students desiring to continue as an assistant may apply for reappointment.
